Guidelines in Applying through the UPIS Varsity Athletic Admission System (UPIS VAAS) AY 2023-2024

For AY 2023-2024, UPIS will admit **fifteen (15) student-athletes from Grades 7-9** through the UPIS VAAS.

QUALIFICATIONS

The applicant must be:

1. an incoming Grade 7, 8, or 9 student;
2. an athlete of top calibre* and who is willing to serve UPIS by being a member of a varsity team;
3. has a general weighted average of **80% or better in AY 2021-2022**; and has **no failing grades** in any quarter.

* *Top calibre means that the athlete must have at the minimum participated and won awards/medals in recognized tournaments such as SBP, Pasarella, PAYA, PRADA, etc. The UPIS Health & PE Department shall evaluate the applicant's achievements using their own rubric.*

UPIS Varsity Athletic Admission System (UPIS VAAS)

Rules Governing UPIS Varsity Athletes

A. Discipline of Athletes

An athlete must

1. Sign the contract with parents' conforme and submit to the APAP.
2. Submit the agreement form enclosed in the UPIS Rules and Regulations Handbook to the class adviser on the first week of classes.
3. Strictly follow the rules and regulations of UPIS.
4. Follow the training rules and programs of the Varsity Coach.
5. Submit a photocopy of the report card to the Sports Coordinator *every quarter* as soon as it is available.
6. Pass all subjects at the end of each academic year.

B. Participation in other Athletic Events

The University Athletic Association of the Philippines (UAAP) is the major league in which UPIS participates. Therefore, UPIS athletes must follow the UAAP eligibility rule that states that *"no athlete of any UAAP institution may play for any other entity for the duration of the UAAP tournament in which he/she is participating, except: exhibition games, barangay tournament, competition under the Department of Education, MASDEC and for national games, provided that in all these cases, he shall have the written approval of his/her University."*
